SIDING

PERMITS, INSPECTIONS AND LICENSES

A Building Permit is required for all siding projects beyond simple repairs. Repairs consist of replacing only individual pieces of cladding. Once an entire wall face is replaced, a water resistive barrier is required, and therefore, a permit is needed before work begins.

Contractors engaged in building projects are most often required to obtain a Contractor's License or Remodeler's License from the State of Minnesota. There are exceptions based on quantity of work and the number of disciplines performed. For more information contact the Building Official or Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry at (651) 284-5069, or www.dli.mn.gov.

Required inspections include:

- 1) **A Water Resistive Barrier prior to installing siding and**
- 2) **A Final inspection when all work is completed.**

Window, Siding, and Water Resistive Barrier manufacture installation instructions shall dictate flashing materials to be used in conjunction with their products. All flashings must be installed for inspection prior to covering. Please allow a minimum of 2 days for inspection requests. Photos will only be accepted with prior approval.

Water Resistive Barrier/ Flashing materials

Minnesota State Building Code stipulates a barrier be placed over all exterior walls with very limited exceptions. Furthermore, Section R703.8 of the Minnesota Residential Code requires all self-adhered membranes used as flashing elements around windows and doors meet standard AAMA 711. Look for this label on products or in their listing material. Any questions about these requirements can be directed to the Building Official.



Electrical Permit Requirements

Re-installation of electrical fixtures commonly associated with residing a home requires an electrical permit and inspections.
