
## **Residential Handrail Requirements**

2015 MN Residential Code R311.7.8

## Handrails:

- Required on at least one side of stairs with four or more risers.
- Shall be continuous for the full length of the stairs and have no sharp edges.
- Ends must return to a wall or post and have no open ends.
- Height shall be 34 inches to 38 inches measured vertically above nosing of treads.
- Shall not project more than 4½ inches on either side of stairway.
- Require a minimum 1½ inch space between it and what it is mounted to.
- Must support a 200 pound force applied at any point along the top.
- The hand grip portion shall be Type I, Type II or provide equivalent graspability.

## **Handrail Mounting**



**Note:** A 2x4 or 2x6 is not acceptable without <u>recessed areas on both sides</u> as shown above.

## \*Handrails must be graspable\*
