M/S Amy Peterson/Chris Olson to approve the minutes of the February 6, 2023 meeting as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Approve Agenda

Planning & Zoning

-A discussion was held about the CUP for Dennis Sharp for the Mini Storage. P&Z recommended passage by the board. Mike read and explained the resolution. The time was changed to 5AM

M/S Chris Olson/Amy Peterson to approve Resolution 2023-02 to change the animal control ordinance so it is more enforceable. Motion passed unanimously.

M/S Chris Olson/Amy Peterson to approve Ordinance 2023-01 amending section 3-2 of the town code relating to animal regulations. Motion passed unanimously.

- -There will be a public hearing on ADU's at March P&Z meeting.
- -Jason spoke with MNDOT they will allow a frontage road to be built near George's greenhouse.
- -Two work meetings have be ok'd for P&Z and will need to be scheduled.
- -Volunteers needed to box scanning stuff.
- -We have heard nothing from Paul Villella.
- -Todd, Mike and Marlys will work on a P&Z budget. Mike Warring gave a county update.

Roads

- -Roads are in good winter condition.
- -Street signs are being ordered. We are waiting on an estimate.
- -We are putting out feelers for paving on the East Side this year.

Fire

-In January the fire district had 87 runs, 11 for Athens. Our response time is 5 minutes.

Parks

- -The Board of Review and Equalization will be held at 7PM on April 17th at the town hall.
- -MATIT insurance was scammed out of 834,197.00.
- -We received confirmation from the Historical Society for destruction and scanning of documents according to township retention schedules.
- -Diane contacted CenturyLink to change our internet and update phone usage.

Treasurer's Report-

M/S Chris Olson/Amy Peterson to approve the Treasurer's Report, Claims List for Approval, and Net Pay Account Distribution Report & IRS (checks 7907-7921 plus IRS totaling 40,437.51). Motion passed unanimously.
